



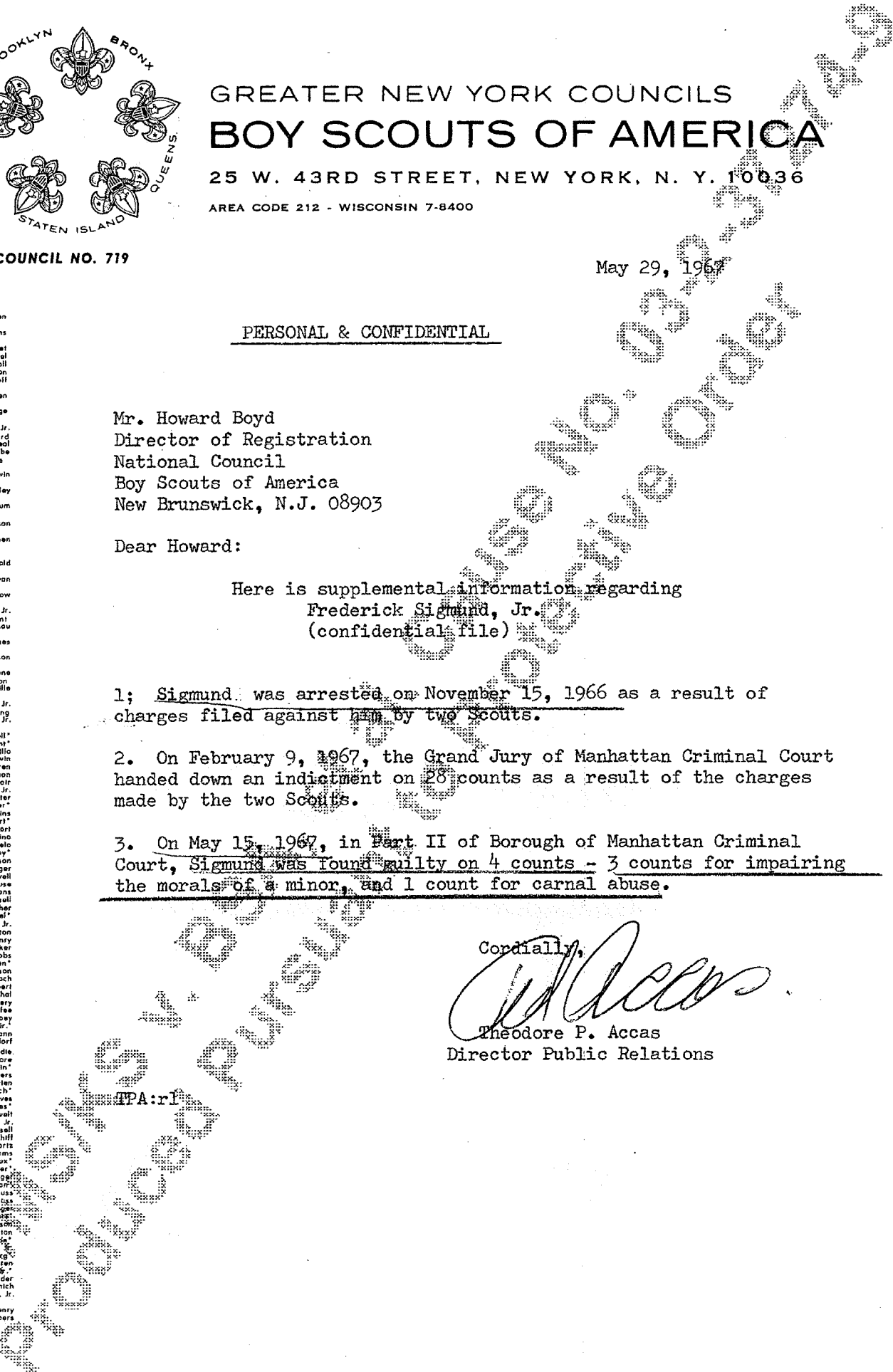

(confidential file)

- 1; Sigmund was arrested on November 15, 1966 as a result of charges filed against him by two Scouts.
2. On February 9, 1967, the Grand Jury of Manhattan Criminal Court handed down an indictment on 28 counts as a result of the charges made by the two Scouts.
3. On May 15, 1967, in Part II of Borough of Manhattan Criminal Court, Sigmund was found guilty on 4 counts - 3 counts for impairing the morals of a minor, and 1 count for carnal abuse.


