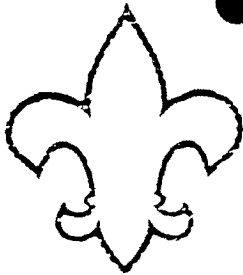

## Sex abuser gets probation

A former Boy Scout counselor was placed on three years probation yesterday for sexually abusing a 13-year-old scout who visited his home to get help in earning a photography merit badge.

As conditions of probation, Nassau County Court Judge Alfred Samenga ordered 44-year-old Gordon Pugh to undergo psychiatric treatment and avoid any association with "young persons."

Pugh, an engineer for the New York Telephone Co., was indicted in June

1975 on charges of second degree sodomy, attempted sodomy, sexual abuse and endangering the welfare of a minor.

The sodomy charges were dropped May 17, after Pugh interrupted his trial and agreed to plead guilty to the two lesser counts.

The indictment alleged Pugh sexually assaulted the boy on two separate occasions in August 1974 when he visited Pugh's home at 89 Trumbull Road, Manhasset.

## Guilty Plea in Sex Case

Mineola—A former Boy Scout Counselor pleaded guilty yesterday to committing sexual abuse on a 13-year-old Scout he was helping on a photography merit badge project.

The advisor, Gordon Pugh, 43, of 39 Troubull Rd., Manhasset, entered the plea to reduced charges of second-degree sexual abuse and endangering the welfare of a minor. Last June, Pugh was indicted on so-bony charges stemming from two separate August, 1974, incidents, in which the boy visited his home. Yesterday, County Court Judge Alfred Sapienza ordered Pugh, who was freed without bail following his arrest, to return to court on July 9 for sentencing. He faces a maximum of two years in jail.

## *Boy Scout Aide Faces Charges of Sex Abuse*

*Mirrors*—A *Manhasset* Boy Scout counselor was indicted by a Nassau County grand jury yesterday on charges of second-degree sodomy, attempted sodomy, sexual abuse and endangering the welfare of a 13-year-old scout.

Assistant Nassau District Attorney Joseph Lauric said that the counselor, Gordon Pugh, 43, of 89 Trumbull Rd., allegedly committed the acts when the boy went to his home twice last August to work on a photography merit badge. Pugh, who was a merit leader counselor, had volunteered to teach scouts photography in his spare time. He was not affiliated with a specific troop.

According to Lauric, the boy's mother did not learn of the incident until April, when she filed a complaint against Pugh.

Pugh was arraigned in Nassau County Court before Judge Raymond L. Wilkes and released in the custody of his attorney, C. Malcolm Dawsey. If convicted, Pugh faces a maximum of seven years' imprisonment for sodomy, four years for attempted sodomy, and one year for each of the other charges. Dawsey said he would not comment on the case at this time.

Pugh is an engineer with the New York Telephone Co.
