



I have reviewed our file on James Steele and find that he was placed on our file originally in early 1989. This was caused by him being charged with sexual abuse of a young girl. He pleaded guilty to the charge and was sentenced to 30 days in jail and three years probation.

Mr. Steele has apparently been removed from probation and requested a Regional Review. The Regional Review Committee upheld the decision of the local council to deny him registration.

I believe all the letters we are receiving from Mr. Steele are really requesting a National Review. They do not come out and say that, but I believe that is what he really wants. There are some handicap or mental problems with Mr. Steele and it may be that he cannot express himself well.

Perhaps, we could end this whole thing if we conducted a National Review and upheld the council and region. This might end all the mail which keeps coming to us over the months.







Dear Mr. Blacker:

On 3/7/89 James Steele appeared in the Oswego City Court and was sentenced to three years probation on the misdemeanor charges of Sexual Abuse, 2nd Degree.

While on probation Mr. Steele was to participate in counseling for sexual perpetrators. The defendant attended the Mental Health Center's 16 week program. Upon completion of the program the counselor, Les Rivkin, reported that he felt Mr. Steele had gained about as much insight into his circumstances as he is going to. Mr. Rivkin also stated that he felt Mr. Steele would most likely not be a repeat offender.

While on probation Mr. Steele was in compliance with other terms of his probation; he was to have no contact with the victim or be in the presence of minor children without probation officer approved supervision.

There was an incident whereby the Steeles were told second hand that the victim was unofficially accusing him of inappropriate picture taking. The Steeles contacted this officer and were advised to contact the authorities. Reportedly they did so and nothing more has been heard.

On 3/15/90 the Honorable James W. McCarthy granted James Steele an early honorable discharge.

At this point in time, this officer has no reason to believe that James Steele would pose a threat to society. However, one cannot predict, nor guarantee, Mr. Steele's future for continued law-abiding behavior.

This officer feels that Mental Health Center Counselor Les Rivkin's reference to Mr. Steele's insight ability best sums up Mr. Steele's present circumstances. Mr. Steele's apparent respect for the criminal court system just may be enough of a deterrent to ensure Mr. Steele's continued law abiding behavior.

Dear Mr. Blacker,

I am writing to you on behalf of James Steele, and his desire to be back involved in some way in Boy Scouts. As you are aware, Jim was convicted of sexual abuse, 2nd degree in March 1989 here in Oswego. Since that time, until just recently, on probation. I believe that Jim is capable of being involved in Scouting under direct supervision — which, for other reasons I have always thought was appropriate.

I am aware of Scouting's understandable and necessary caution with regard to these matters. And yet, I believe that this case does have some mitigating circumstances which allow for some flexibility. While Jim pleaded guilty to the charge, it is not at all clear that he was, in fact, guilty of the crime. While I have not personally seen the police report, I do know the persons involved, all of them being related in some way to this church, and I cannot say that it is clear that the persons bringing the charges were acting without other motives.

I am sure that Jim was not fully aware of what was going on in the court process, because of his limited intelligence, and because his court appointed lawyer may not have been able to help him understand what was being asked of him.

Because there seems to be no patter here, and because Jim is asking for participation in Scouting that still means no contact with boys while unsupervised, I would support that request. I would appreciate your response to this request, not only sent to Jim, but shared with me, in as much as I will have a continuing relationship with him as his pastor.

As you know, I was put on probation for three years for sexual abuse that I have not done. Here's what went on that night.

came to my home and asked be to babysit on 9/19/87. While they went to a party. And then they told me what to do that night when it was time for her to go to bed. She did that, and then gave me a hug and a kiss, and then she went to her bedroom. Then I told her to get a toy or a doll, but she wouldn't, so I got one for her, and then she went to bed. Then, after she was in bed for two hours, I went to look in on her, but she was not in bed, and so I told her to go to sleep. When came back home, I went home.

The next day, the city Police Department came and they took me in, and one week later, I was charged with the crime. After about four months of various court appearances, on the advice of my attorney, Mr. Spencer Lunnington, I pled guilty to a charge of sexual abuse, and was sentenced to 30 days in the Oswego County Jail, and three years probation.

Due to the facts of this case, I think that I should be allowed back into scouting. I hope you will consider my request positively.

# APPLICANT PROCEDURE FOR REQUESTING REVIEW OF DECISION

#### DENYING REGISTRATION

- If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. This request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
- 2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the president of the local council shall appoint a committee to review the situation.
- 3. The appointed committee should review the facts as presented, and, in addition, may interview any persons whose testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
- 4. A confidential report will be given to the applicant setting forth the decision of the committee.
- 5. The applicant may if he or she does not agree with the decision request a review from the Regional Director.
- 6. If the Regional review does not satisfy the applicant, he or she may ask for futher review by the National Council. The decision by the National Council is final.
