# 11 PERSONS Sentenced

Sentences were issued to 11 persons Tuesday in Tompkins County Court by presiding Judge Bruce G. Dean.

Sentenced were:

— Donald Hairston of Elmira, who received a five-year probationary term with a stipulation that the Probation Department consider psychiatric treatment for Hairston. Hairston had pleaded guilty in June to second-degree assault. A November 1971 indictment charged Hairston originally with second-degree burglary and first-degree sexual abuse in connection with an earlier incident at the North Campus Dorm on the Cornell University campus.

— John Steel, 21, of Ithaca, received two three-year probationary terms to run concurrently on charges of criminal possession of a weapon and sixth-degree criminal possession of a dangerous drug. Steel had originally been charged with third-degree criminal sale of a dangerous drug in connection with a February incident when he is accused of selling heroin to a State Police undercover agent. He pleaded guilty to the reduced charge in September.

— Linda Vorasi Steel, 24, of Ithaca, received a three-year probationary term. She had pleaded guilty in September to a charge of sixth-degree criminal possession of a dangerous drug in connection with the incident involving John Steel.

— Robert Alton Bentley of Caroline was fined \$250 on a charge of attempted third-degree assault. Bentley had pleaded to the charge in the second day of a March jury trial in which he faced charges of second-degree assault and resisting arrest in connection with an alleged fight in November 1971.

of 403 College Ave. was sentenced to a three-year probationary term on charges of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and possession of stolen property, both misdemeanors.

In March, a Tompkins County jury returned the misdemeanor verdict, although the District Attorney had sought felony convictions in connection with an October 1971 incident when he is accused of possessing a stolen car and property owned by Cornell.

— Morris Ray, 20, of Ithaca, was sentenced to a five-year probationary term on condition he enroll himself in the drug correction program at Alpha House. Ray had pleaded guilty to a charge of third-degree burglary on June 22.

— James Warren Smith of Groton was sentenced to a five-year probationary term. Smith had pleaded guilty in June to a charge of third-degree sodomy.

— James Oscar Ware, 52, of 123 Miller Rd., Danby, was sentenced to a three-month term in Tompkins County jail on charges of driving while intoxicated as a felony. A May indictment charged him with the offense. A second conviction of driving while intoxicated in a 10-year period constitutes a felony. Ware's sentence will be served during nights and week-ends.

— Robert Oakes, 28, of 103 E. Spencer St., received a five-year probationary term on charges of driving while intoxicated as a felony, and criminal mischief. Oakes was also ordered to seek treatment for alcoholism. A May indictment charged Oakes with drunken driving in April, on a city street, and of later causing damage in the lock-up cells of the Ithaca Police Department. He was also ordered to make restitution.
