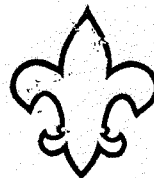

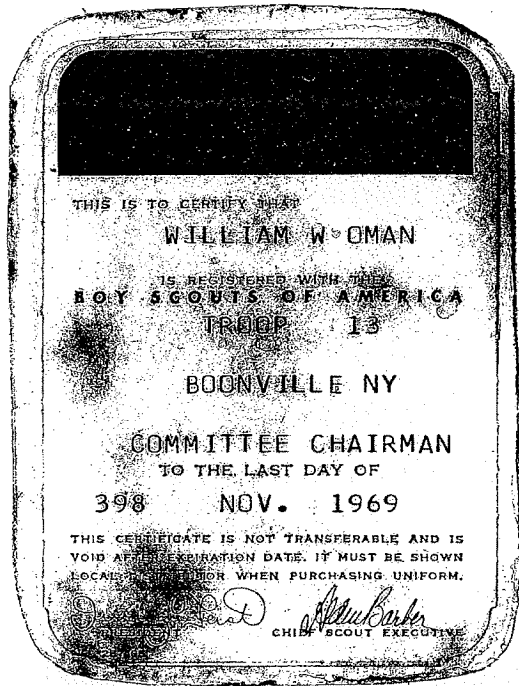

Has worked at Scout camp summers.


Arrested for endangering welfare of child. Pled guilty. Given suspended sentence. Released on probation.
